Heritage Christian Academy High School Dress Code 2025-2026

School uniforms are required for all high school students (7th - 12th) attending Heritage Christian Academy. All uniforms are to be neat, clean, and in good condition. Torn, tattered, or dirty uniforms are unacceptable.

Heritage Christian Academy students are to wear only school-approved shirts and bottoms. HCA has a contract with FlynnO'Hara for uniforms.

Dress Code Guidelines:

All shirts are to be tucked into pants, skirts, etc. (young men and ladies). All pants and skirts are to be worn around the waist and are not to be lowered, rolled down, or rolled under. Skirts are not to have the hemlines shortened with lengths shorter than the **bottom of the knee**.

Only white undershirts are allowed under shirts.

Girls jewelry should be modest, not extreme. Earrings may be worn in lobe of ear only. No more than two per ear. Body jewelry, such as belly button rings, tongue rings, and other body piercings are not allowed.

Only school sweaters or jackets are to be worn indoors during school hours. Belts must be black or brown, solid or braided leather. Belts must have plain, small buckles. Belts must be worn with <u>all</u> pants and skirts with belt loops.

Socks, when worn, are to be in solid white, navy, and black and may have small logos or thin-colored bands or trim. Tights with feet or footless tights may be worn in white, navy, black, brown, and tan. Full-length leggings/tights (to the ankle) may be worn under uniform skirts from *October through March* in colors white, black, navy, brown, and tan.

No sandals, open back shoes, or flip flops are to be worn during these months. Shoes must be correctly laced and tied at all times. Crocs are allowed for girls only (shoe-like versions ONLY, such as girl's Mary Jane's etc.). No open backs or holes!

Students may wear boots to school during the colder months: <u>October through March ONLY</u>. Boots must not have high heels, chains, spikes, or spurs. Shoes must be correctly laced and tied at all times. Athletic shoes are not allowed for daily wear. This includes all basketball, running, and skating shoes, etc. In addition, boys must wear shoes with socks. No sandals, flip flops, or Crocs. Athletic shoes are still required for physical education.

Students are not to have tattoos - permanent or temporary. This includes drawing on the skin.

Jewelry of any kind, except watches and rings, is not to be worn by male students.

A boy's hair is to be neatly trimmed, off of the collar and ears, and out of the eyes. Traditional haircuts are expected. Dreadlocks and corn rows are not allowed. Fad haircuts are not allowed. The administration will determine suitability of haircuts. Boys are to be clean shaven at all times. This includes mustaches.

Uniforms are to be worn at all times! A change of clothing can occur only after school is dismissed <u>and</u> the student is <u>off school grounds</u>. A HCA PE Uniform is required for 7th-9th grade since they are required to change clothes during Physical Education class.

As stated before, the dress code will be enforced. Please make sure that your child is in compliance each morning before coming to school. <u>Heritage Christian Academy</u> <u>administration has the authority to determine whether or not an item is acceptable to dress code</u>. 2025-2026 Schedule of Fees

PRE-REGISTRATION: \$250.00 for K-5 - Grade 12 (Non-refundable, Non-transferable)
Pre-Registration for the 2025-2026 school year will begin February 5th. It will end on March 14th.
Everyone who pre-registers will receive a discount on tuition.

REGISTRATION: \$300.00 for K-5-Grade 12 (Non-refundable, Non-transferable) - Does not apply if you pre-registered.

The registration fee is due upon application. The registration provides for the staff, supplies, and equipment to maintain the school office that manages parent/student affairs, cumulative folders, and accounting records.

STUDENT RESOURCE FEE K5 \$425.00 per student; 1st_12th \$550.00 per student (Non-refundable after August 1, 2025)

The Student Resource Fee covers the cost of the books, student insurance, certain student supplies, and classroom teaching supplements. This fee also provides for vehicle fuel costs for field trips, computer/software upgrades and replacements, and technology improvements. Students will also receive the yearbook without additional cost.

LATE FEES AND RETURNED CHECKS

A late fee of \$20.00 is added to the students account after the 5th of the month. A returned check results in a \$35 returned check fee to cover bank charges.

General Financial Policies:

- A student will not be enrolled in HCA if there is a previous financial obligation to another school. Before a student will be admitted to the school, all previous tuition and fees must be liquidated.
- Any account that is outstanding 60 days after due date may cause the student to be suspended until payment is brought up to date. In addition, any account that is outstanding for more than 60 days will cause the student(s) to become ineligible for any extracurricular activities.
- 3. At the end of a semester, if there are any financial obligations, fees, or late charges, the child will not be allowed to take his/her final examination, participate in Kindergarten or High School graduation, or any other activity involving HCA. We will not report a grade for that semester or release student records for that student until the account is current.

Graduation Requirements

HCA offers two levels of diplomas: general & college preparatory. All students entering 9th grade are automatically signed up for college preparatory classes, unless special arrangements are made with the parents.

Any student who receives a college preparatory diploma is eligible for admission to any UNC institution of higher learning provided he/she has the SAT test scores and GPA needed for acceptance.

All graduating Seniors must meet the following requirements for a college preparatory diploma:

English 4 units Foreign Language 2 units

Mathematics 4 units (to include Algebra I & II and

Pre-Calculus)

Science 4 units (to include Physical

Science, Biology, Chemistry and

Physics)

Social Studies 3 units (including U.S. History)

Health & PE 1 unit

Electives 6 units (including 1 Bible for each

year at HCA)

TOTAL: 24 units

Students who choose to receive a general diploma must take the same number of credits; however, all of the college preparatory subjects are not required.

Students receiving a general diploma must make a total battery of at least 10 on the Stanford Achievement Test. Likewise, students receiving a college preparatory diploma must make a total battery of at least 11 on the Stanford Achievement Test.

To receive credit for a college preparatory class (9th - 12th), there must be a passing average for the year and you can not fail more than one quarter.

For a non-college preparatory class you must have an annual passing grade.

HCA Discipline Agreement Form

One of the most important lessons education should teach is discipline. While it does not appear to be a subject, it underlies the whole educational structure. With an understanding of the purpose of discipline in a school, a person may form a correct attitude toward it, and not only do his part in making his school an effective place of learning, but also develop the habit of self-restraint which will make someone a better person.

At Heritage Christian Academy, we believe that it is very important to "Train up a child the way he should go." (Proverbs 22:6) Good training and good discipline should be centered in and on Christ. Discipline is administered in love, counseling, and understanding.

Our teachers must have a high standard for behavior in the classroom. They are responsible for discipline in their classroom, lunchroom, and bathrooms. When a child misbehaves, the teacher is to punish them with love and kindness to show the student that he is loved. We believe that the faculty has the right to punish a child whenever necessary. Hebrews 13:7 says, "obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves..."

We will enforce a six-inch personal contact rule while students are on campus. No personal bodily contact will be permitted at any time or any place. Griping is not tolerated. Legitimate complaints and constructive suggestions to the proper persons are always encouraged. Horseplay or general rowdiness such as pushing, running in the classroom, playing in the halls, etc. is not permitted.

Severe discipline problems such as lying, cheating, cursing, and the like will not be tolerated. These problems could result in suspension or dismissal.
